

IMSS 2020 Virtual Meeting

Dear Attendee:

Welcome to this virtual continuing education event. At this meeting we will use **ASCLS online CE Organizer**. You will use this online program to generate your P.A.C.E.[®] certificate for the meeting.

At the end of each session, the Session Host will announce a unique session code for that particular session. **Record the session number**. You will need this number to get credit for attending the session. We suggest that you write this number on the back of this sheet at the end of each session. When the Seminar concludes, go to the ASCLS web site and proceed as follows:

1. At the ASCLS homepage, www.ascls.org, click on CE Organizer under the Quick Links. Quick Links can be found on the right hand side of the home page.
2. When you are taken to the CE Organizer page, scroll down to the bottom of the page and follow the instructions for logging in, depending on whether you are a member or not.
 - a. ASCLS members will log in using the same username and password used to enter the Members Section of the website.
 - b. If you do not have a username and password, follow the link to register.
 - c. If you are not an ASCLS member, click the “Register Here” link to create a username and password.
3. Once logged in, click on **Claim Credit**.
4. Click on **ASLCS Regional and State Events** tab.
5. Scroll down to ASCLS - Montana and click on **View Region**.
6. On the next screen, check the corresponding box for every session you attended and click Next at the bottom of the page.
 - a. Due to this being a Virtual Meeting, session times will not exactly match the times the sessions are happening. Sessions will go in chronological order with the earliest time coinciding with the earliest session and going forward in time.
7. On the following screen enter the unique session code for each session and click Next.
8. You must fill out the Evaluation in order to claim your certificate. Click **Complete Survey**.
9. On the final screen you can print and/or save your certificate. Certificates will be saved to your transcript for later viewing.

All sessions are being recorded so you can view them again or for the first time, at a later date. Sessions will be available for 30 days following the end of the Seminar. Claim 25 credits in all! More information to come for the recordings.

If you are a member of ASCLS, you can link your account to ASCP so your transcripts are directly applied to the BOC website for those that recertify every 3 years. Add non-ASCLS P.A.C.E. credits by uploading your certificate or an image of your certificate. Only jpg or PDF files are accepted. This certificate info will transfer to the BOC for all ASCLS members.
