POSITION DESCRIPTION

1. PURPOSE

Encourage and facilitate development of developing professional members into active members and new leaders. Serve as a communication link between the national Developing Professional Forum and the state Developing Professional Representatives.

2. TERM OF OFFICE

1 year

Maximum number of terms allowed: None, but person must remain eligible for the Developing Professional member category

3. QUALIFICATIONS

ASCLS Developing Professional membership and reside in Region VIII Recommended experience that would be helpful to someone holding this office: Previous leadership position in an organization. State Developing Professional Representative experience very helpful.

4. DUTIES

Mentor developing professionals in all states in the region to become involved in ASCLS. Provide resources to assist the Developing Professional members and state Developing Professional Representatives. Provide feedback to the national Developing Professional Forum about state and regional developing professional activities and issues.

Reports to: Region VIII Council Chair

Other duties performed: Special projects that encourage Developing Professional member development such as Employment forums, Student Bowl, leadership training opportunities. Participate in Council activities

5. EXPECTATIONS

Meeting attendance &Travel requirements: Attend at least two (out of three) Region VIII Council meetings per year – fall conference call, winter conference call, and national meeting site (summer)

Reports: Fall, Winter, Final reports to Region VIII Council Chair

Deadlines: as assigned by Regional Director

Average time commitment: Approximately 4 hours per month

Financial considerations: Travel expenses and registration to national meeting
